zVPS Version 5 does z/OS and more....

After 30 years of firsts and bests, Velocity Software is looking at where else the mainframe as we know it can be improved. Applications such as MONGODB, SpectrumScale/GPFS, DOCKER now have support. ILMT support allows easier understanding and control over your software costs. The z/OS platform has some complexities that could be easily (for us) improved. With no java, no need for ziips, efficient code, and the ability to utilize all the z/VM tools, zVPS will now absorb SMF records and start providing z/OS performance management functions on the same pane of glass as your z/VM, network, VSE, Linux and distributed platforms.

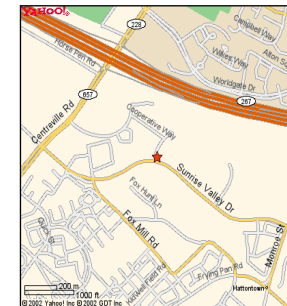
Coming Soon to a z/VM near you
